Despite the revelation of his lineage, his commitment to the Camarilla and the prosperity of Indianapolis was unwavering. A nihilist at heart, Smitty viewed existence through a lens of detached cynicism, yet paradoxically, his rule brought a semblance of stability to the city. Under his leadership, Indianapolis flourished, his pragmatic decisions guided by a ruthless pragmatism that brooked no dissent. His impact on the city was profound, leaving behind a legacy of pragmatic governance tempered by the cold logic of his nihilistic worldview.

- Emptiness of Faith: Those with True Faith are a danger to any vampire; their holy righteousness burns through ancient blood and bone. You, however, do not fear these vessels of god's wrath. Whether due to a devotion to your clan's pagan traditions or a resolute denial of all spirituality, you are immune to the effects of True Faith, level 1 and True Faith level 5. You still may be affected by True Faith levels 2-4.
- •• Nihilist: Life is meaningless, so too is unlife. As such, you seem to others to have no soul. Anytime the Auspex Power of Scry the Soul is used on you, you gain a 5-trait bonus on the challenge.
- ••• Nothing Really Matters: You can take Fortitude at In-Clan cost and are able to take it without a teacher. Additionally, the effects Toughness and Aegis are doubled.
